
Flash estimate - July 2014

Euro area annual inflation down to 0.4%

Euro area¹ annual inflation² is expected to be 0.4% in July 2014, down from 0.5% in June³, according to a flash estimate⁴ from **Eurostat**, the statistical office of the European Union.

Looking at the main components of **euro area** inflation, services is expected to have the highest annual rate in July (1.3%, stable compared with June), followed by non-energy industrial goods (0.0%, compared with -0.1% in June), food, alcohol & tobacco (-0.3%, compared with -0.2% in June) and energy (-1.0%, compared with 0.1% in June).

The complete set of harmonised indices of consumer prices (HICP) for the euro area, EU and Member States is released around the middle of the month following the reference month. The next release with full data for July 2014 is scheduled for 14 August 2014.
